

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Company Selection Criteria & Process

Tech Tour Growth

Universe

European private companies meeting three of the criteria:

- >€10 mn in revenue
- >€20 mn in total funding
- >€100mn valuation
- >min revenue growth pa on average over the last 3 years
 - 80% for companies with €10-30mn in revenues
 - 50% for companies with €30-100mn in revenues
- List reviewed by selection committee and published in Dec 2016
- Company CEOs invited to join Tech Tour Growth Forum

Committee selects TT Growth 50 from Growth Universe - removing "unicorns" considering:

- Innovation potential
- Management Team
- Pedigree (quality of backers, advisory board, past awards won and top sector listings)



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
The Tech Tour Growth 50 identifies, analyses and shines a bright light on Europe's potential future billion dollar businesses

- TT Growth 50 lists the top 50 investor backed highgrowth companies over a rolling three year period.
- The list is based on value, not just valuation, with growth metrics revenue combined with the judgement of leading investors in the selection committee
- CEOs are invited to, and celebrated at, the Tech Tour Growth Forum
- The companies are profiled on <u>www.techtourgrowth50.com</u> all year round with attracting significant media coverage

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It's healthy to remain wary of lists...but we think this one deserves attention: meet 50 of Europe's fastest-growing tech companies, as compiled by Tech Tour.



Key Facts - Tech Tour Growth 50 2015

- TTG50 Companies raised over \$5 Billion
- TTG50 Companies created over 15,000 Jobs
- ❖ 75% of the TTG50 companies were founded in the last 10 years
- The median year of company foundation is 2007
- The average time from company foundation to first funding round is 3 years 6 months and from first funding round to most recent funding round is almost 4 years
- The mean number of funding rounds is 4
- 223 different investors backed the 50 companies
- ❖ 83% of investors are in just one TTG50 company
- Mean number of investors per company is 5
- ❖ 47 of the 50 companies have at least one US investor
- ❖ 28 companies are Tech Tour "alumni", presenting at past Tech Tour events

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
