## Machine learning, energy transition, big data and cutting edge solar technologies on show at the 2018 Cleantech Summit Energy Transition

**21 November 2018** – Tech Tour announces today the 30 scale-up cleantech companies who have been selected to present at the <u>2018 Cleantech Summit Energy Transition</u>. These companies represent the very best investment opportunities within the cleantech sector in Europe and follow on from 8 successful past editions of the Summit where 205 companies have presented since 2013 and who have generated a total of €579 million in deal value. Past presenting companies generating upward of €20 million in investment following their participation include Avantium, Green Biologics, Glo AB and FRX Polymers.

With a special focus on Energy Transition, the <u>30 selected companies</u> are active in energy generation and storage, energy efficiency, big data and analytics, industry, offshore, smart cities, smart mobility and logistics. The companies come from across Europe with the majority based in the Netherlands (28%) and remainder from Germany (10%), Italy (10%), the United Kingdom (8%), France (5%), Sweden (3%), Portugal (3%), Norway (3%), Finland (3%), Denmark (3%) and Israel (3%).

Summit Vice-President, **Aruna Subramanian** (SABIC Ventures), who acted as head of the Selection Committee of the presenting companies had this to say: "*Energy Transition is more topical than ever before and the market is racing towards alternative solutions in every sector. As a selection panel, we have attempted to reflect current industry dynamics and challenges in the technologies we chose to showcase at this event*".

The <u>City of Rotterdam</u> acts as the backdrop to this year's edition and is a city which aspires to be a leading player in the Energy Transition, presenting a unique opportunity to set an example for how to manage this transition in close collaboration with the petrochemical sector which has a huge presence in the city/port.

Summit President, **Klaas de Boer** (Entrepreneurs Fund) noted: "Every day there are headlines in the papers telling us why we need the energy transition now. My ambition for this Cleantech Summit is to help emerging European leaders in the space gain access to capital and other resources to bring their solutions to market at scale in as short a timeframe as possible."
