SOPHiA GENETICS and Cloud&Heat win Tech Tour 2019 Growth & Innovation Awards

Last night at the Tech Tour Growth Summit & Awards held in Lausanne, Switzerland, the Tech Tour announced its 2019 Growth and Innovation Award winners. These were chosen from the 2019 Tech Tour Growth 50 companies, a group of Europe's most promising super-scale up companies, which in turn were selected from a long list of 312 companies.

The selection committee, chaired by Falk Müller-Veerse, Partner, Bryan Garnier & Co, and made up of 21 international venture capital and growth equity fund managers, chose both Award winners taking into account their achievement, impact and momentum.

SOPHiA GENETICS, the Swiss-based global leader in Data-Driven Medicine, took the Growth Award, joining past Award winners including, Darktrace, Devialet, Klarna, MySql, Octo Telematics, Parallels, QlikTech, and Skyscanner.
