


GEOGRAPHICAL FOCUS

LESSONS LEARNED

A lot is already happening...

- The port and maritime sector shows **plenty of innovative initiatives** as seen in:
 - The RPF pipeline and dealflow;
 - Number of start/scale-ups participating in events (Tech Tour, PortXL, InnoEnergy Business Booster, ...)

...results require

• The maritime sector is a very **capital intensive** and therefore **conservative** and **traditional** sector, which results in **longer periods before innovative propositions achieve** (wide-spread) **market adoption**; this calls for longer holding periods compared to investments in other industries

...better together

- Create partnerships/network
- Founder/owner
- Early & late funders
- Business model experts & industry experts

The **sector's size** and (economic and societal) **importance** combined with the **future challenges** (energy transition) and constant **search** and apparent **room** for **operational improvements** (through digitization) provide for innovation


